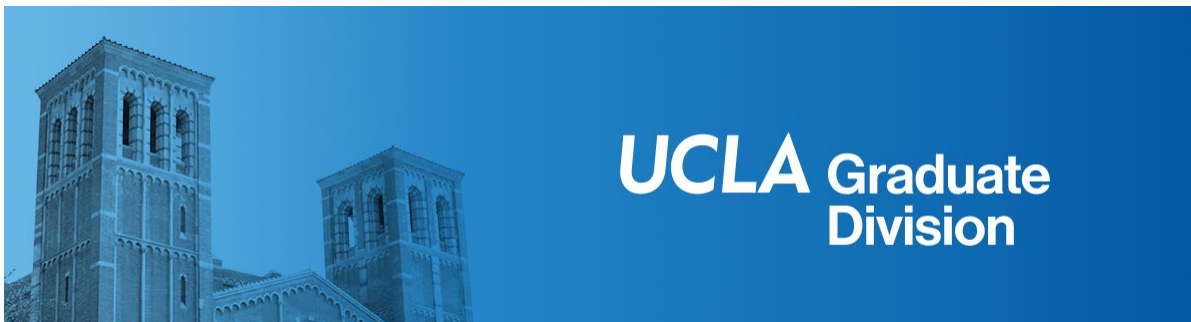

Subject: Reminder - Call for Nominations: 2022 Chancellor's Award for Postdoctoral Research

What you need to know:

- Deadline for submitting nominations is 5 p.m. on Friday, September 23, 2022
- Up to eight postdoctoral scholars will receive a stipend in the amount of \$7500
- Award ceremony will be on Wednesday, November 9, 2022 at CNSI

Dear Colleagues:

This is a reminder for faculty to submit nominations for the **2022 Chancellor's Award for Postdoctoral Research**. This prize was established in 1998 to recognize the important contributions that postdoctoral scholars make to UCLA's research mission.

The deadline for submitting nominations is 5 p.m. (PST) on Friday, September 23, 2022.

Up to eight current or recent postdoctoral scholars will be selected to receive a plaque and a stipend in the amount of \$7,500. The scholars and their faculty research mentors will be recognized during our **UCLA Postdoctoral Scholars and Mentors Awards Ceremony on Wednesday, November 9, 2022 from 3 – 5:30 p.m. at the California Nanosystems Institute (CNSI)**. Those selected to receive the award will be notified in advance of this celebration and will be expected to attend the event.

The eligibility, selection criteria, and nomination process for the *Chancellor's Award for Postdoctoral Scholar Research* can be found on the [Postdoctoral Scholars website](#). Each department or institute may select **up to two nominations** to forward to the Graduate Division for consideration by the award selection committee. Departments or institutes with 35 or more postdoctoral scholars may nominate up to three candidates; those with 60 or more scholars may nominate up to four. The postdoctoral scholar's mentor is responsible for preparing and submitting the full nomination package to the department or institute chair or their designee.

Please be sure to check your submission for completeness as incomplete submissions or submissions without the appropriate signatures will not be reviewed after the deadline. We encourage early submission to catch any issues that would need to be corrected for the nomination to be eligible for review.
